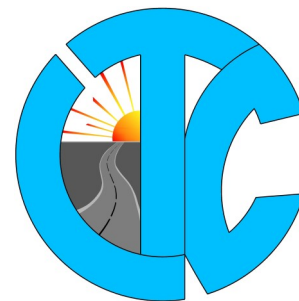


# PRATICAL NURSING

**Practical Nursing** prepares students for employment as licensed practical nurses. The program includes theoretical instruction and clinical experience in medical, surgical, obstetric, pediatric, and geriatric nursing. With clinical experience in acute care, long term care, and community settings.

\* Students must complete their graduation requirements through Charlotte Virtual School. Students are prepared to sit for the FL Board of Nursing NCLEX LPN licensure at completion of program.



Requirements: Admittance is based on current academic course history, 3.0 grade point average, FSA scores, attendance record, faculty recommendation, and interview process. Students must be able to pass a background check, drug test, and physical prior to entrance into the program. Students must be able to drive to clinical rotation sites.
