Principles of Teaching provides students with skills needed to become a competent professional in the field of education. Students begin the program as Juniors and intern in their senior year. This includes an understanding of education in the United States, the ability to work effectively with students, classroom management, communication and other skills needed to support the learning activities of students. This program is intended for students wanting to pursue a Bachelor of Science degree in Education at a 4 year university.



Program Length is two years or 4 credits.

Observation and Field experience hours:

- A minimum of 20 hours of field experience and guided observations during Introduction to the Teaching Profession.
- A minimum of 30 hours planned, guided observations during Human Growth & Development.
- A minimum of 50 hours of guided observations and field experiences during Foundations of Curriculum and Instruction.
- A minimum of 150 hours of internship in an approved setting during Principle of Teaching Internship.

* The creation of a comprehensive educational portfolio is a capstone requirement for this program.



Requirements: Admittance is based on current academic course history, grade point average, attendance record and faculty recommendation. This is a two year commitment.
