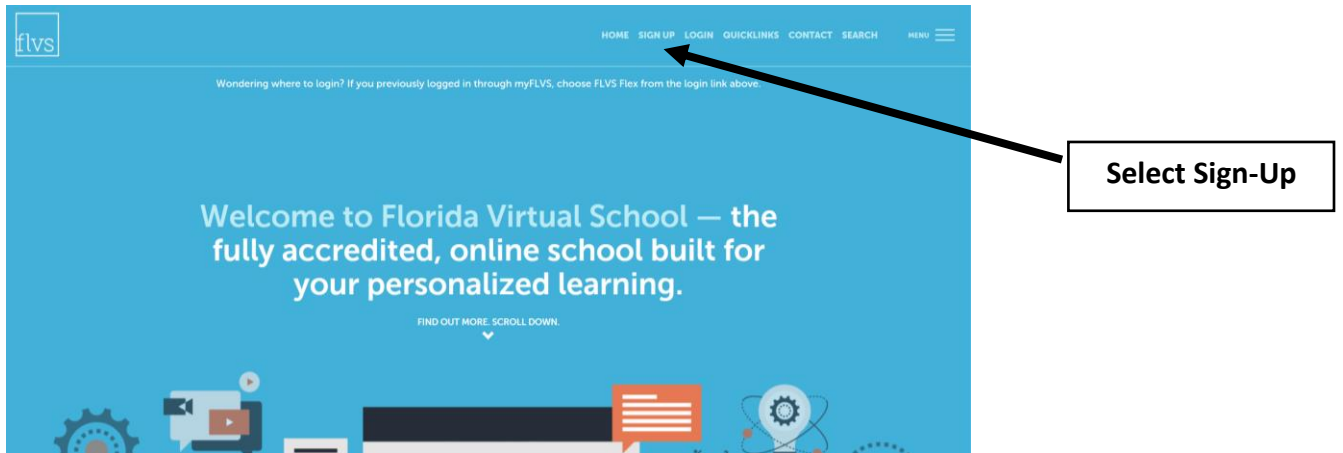
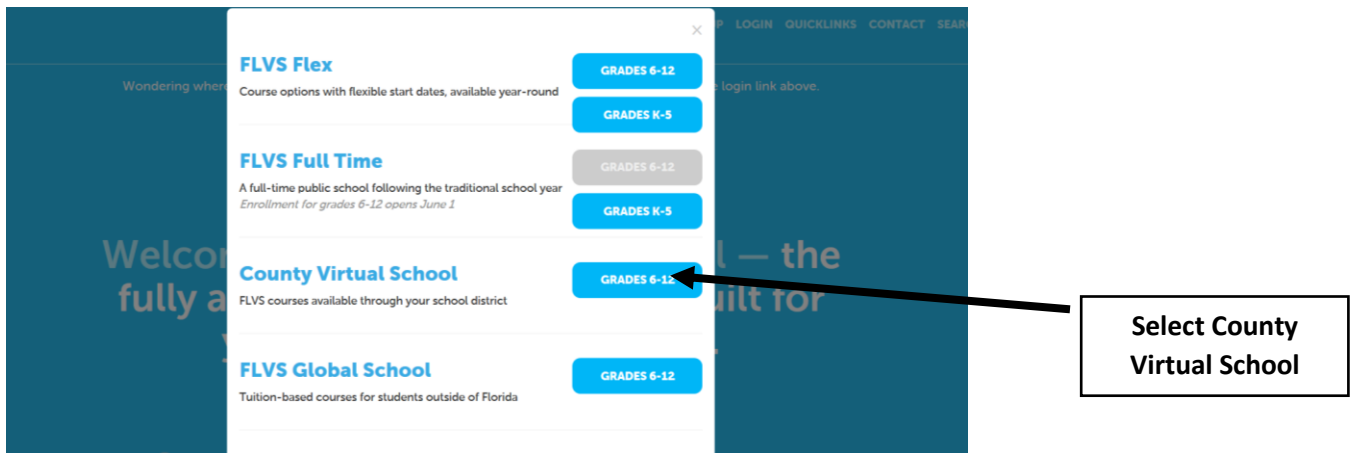

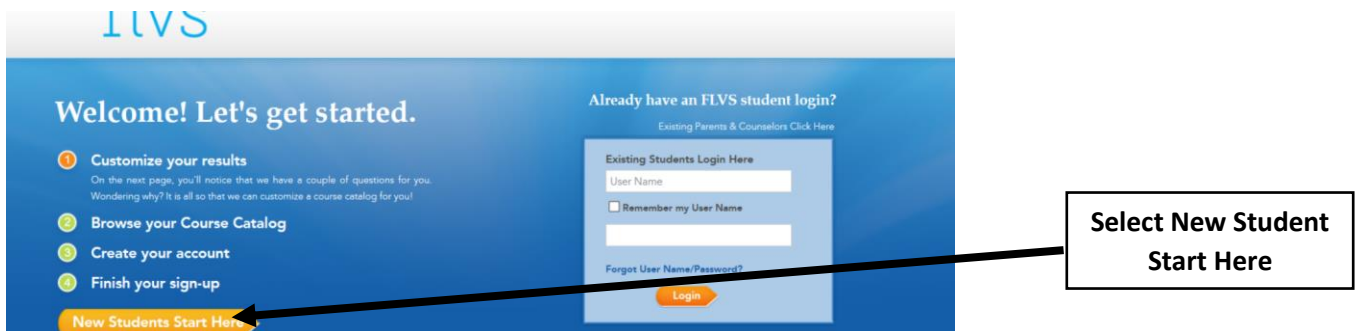
1. Log onto www.flvs.net It will take you to the page below



2. Student selects County Virtual School




3. Select New Students Start here.


4. Student selects that he/she lives in Florida and the County:


5. Student Selects Public/Charter School and clicks continue:

6. Student selects the educational level of the course and the individual course:


